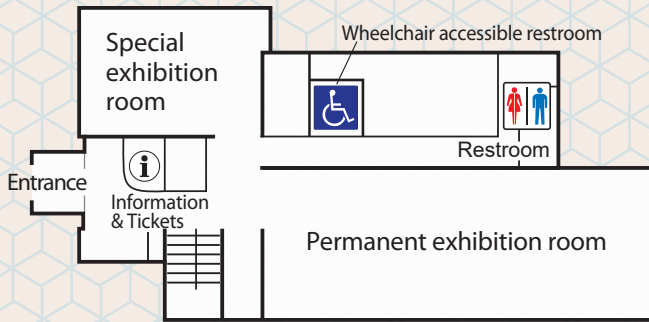


## Facility Information

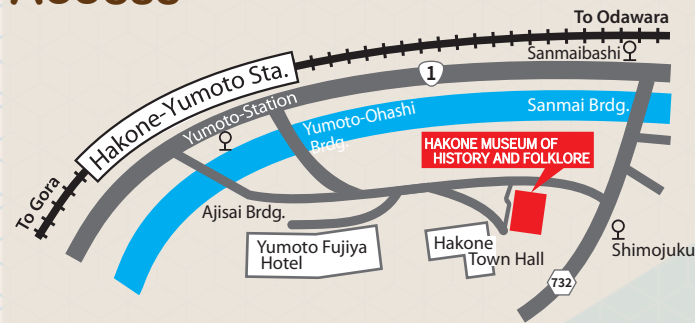
