

Hakone Town Garbage Disposal Guide

Please place garbage out on the color-coordinated days indicated on your neighborhood's "Hakone Town Garbage Collection Calendar".

Place all garbage out by 8:30 AM on collection day.

Recyclable Waste Collection

Cans

- Please place cans in their appropriate containers at the collection site.
- Please use up all the contents and rinse.

Drink cans
Food cans
18L cans, etc.



PET Bottles



Bottles with the PET marking



- Place inside clear or semi-transparent bags.
- Remove cap and label, and rinse out bottle.
- Bottle caps and labels should be disposed of in plastic containers.

Used Paper

- Separate by category and cross-tie.

Newspapers
Cardboard
Mixed Paper
magazines, packaging



Drink Cartons



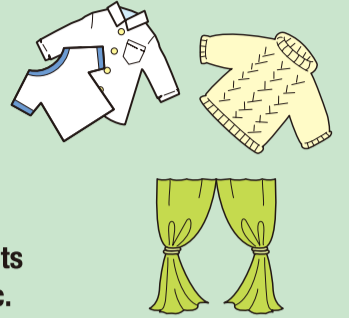
Other Paper Waste

*Any paper that cannot be bound with string should be placed in paper bags and envelopes labeled: その他紙

Fabric

- Place inside clear or semi-transparent bags.
- Do NOT place out on rainy days.

Shirts
Sheets
Towels
Sweaters
Cardigans
Suits
Jeans
Down Jackets
Curtains, etc.



Non-burnable Waste

- Please place items in their appropriate containers at the collection site.

Glass Bottles

- Please use up all the contents and rinse.

Drink bottles
Large sake bottles
Cooking ingredient bottles
Cosmetic bottles, etc.



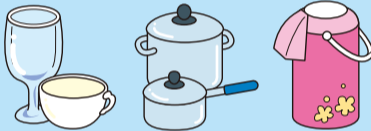
Dry Cell Batteries

- To dispose of nickel-cadmium batteries, lithium batteries, coin batteries, or cellphone batteries, please consult your local retail store.



Other (Items smaller than 50 cm)

- **Earthenware**
bowls, plates, vases, etc.
- **Glass Products**
mirrors, cups, broken glass, etc.
- **Metals**
metal scrap, pipes, etc.
- **Small Metal Objects** (wrap in paper)
pushpins, nails, needles, clips, etc.
- **Composite Metal Items**
pots, pans, umbrellas, etc.
- **Small Appliances**
hair dryers, electric kettles, etc.



Spray Cans

Aerosol cans
Gas canisters
Disposable lighters



- Please use up all contents and do not open a hole in the can.

Lights

Fluorescent lights
Light bulbs (including LEDs)



Plastics - Containers & Wrappers

Items with marking

Plastic trays
Cups / Bottles
Tubes

Wrapping materials

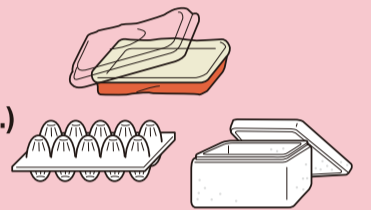
Plastic containers

Plastic caps / labels

Packaging materials (Styrofoam, etc.)

*Styrofoam boxes do not need to be placed in bags for collection.

- Place inside clear or semi-transparent bags and place inside the net at your collection site.
- Plastic forks, spoons, toothbrushes, etc. should be disposed of in Burnable Waste.



Used Cooking Oil

- Place in bottles with caps and place out at the Used Cooking Oil collection site.
- Automobile / machinery oil CANNOT be collected.



Burnable Waste Collection

Burnable Waste

- Place inside a designated bag and make sure to tie the bag shut.

Non-recyclable Paper

Tissue paper
Diapers
Paper contaminated with odor, etc.



Leather / Rubber Products

Bags, belts,
gloves, shoes, etc.



Plastic Items

• Items other than plastic containers
Toys, stationary, discs,
toothbrushes, wash basins, etc.



Branches, Scrap Wood, Grass, Leaves

Branches / Scrap Wood



- Branches and scrap wood should be less than 5 cm thick and less than 30 cm in length per piece, and tied into bundles less than 30 cm in diameter. Anything larger should be disposed of as Large Garbage.

Grass / Leaves

- Grass and leaves should be disposed of in designated waste bags.

Non-collectable Waste Items

Large Garbage

- Items over 50 cm in length on one side
- Door-to-Door Collection (reserve by phone in advance) 500 yen per item. Up to 2 items per collection. Items between 50 cm and 2 m. Up to 100 kg in weight. Collection Days: 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month. TEL: 0460-83-6596
 - Carry-in to Environmental Center 23 yen per kg

Small Electronics

- Items that run via electrical cords or batteries and are smaller than 15 cm x 30 cm
- Dispose of at the collection boxes located at the Town Hall Main Office / Onsen Branch Office / Miyagino Branch Office / Sengokuhara Branch Office / Hakone Branch Office
- Mon - Fri (excluding year end/New Year holidays) 8:30 AM - 5:15 PM



Waste that cannot be processed in Hakone Town

Recyclable Appliances

TVs, refrigerators, freezers, AC, washing machines, dryers

- Contact the retailer where the item was purchased.
- Bring to the disposal site designated by the manufacturer. *
- Contact a licensed general waste collection and transportation business.
- Carry-in to the Environmental Center (requires separate transportation fee of 1,500 yen) * *Recycling slip must be purchased from Post Office in advance.

Items the town cannot collect

- Please contact your local retailers or disposal professionals about such items.

Computers, motorcycles, oil (other than cooking oil), rocks, gravel, sand, electronic organs, pianos, organs, gas tanks, safes (fireproof type), building waste material, concrete products, large ceramics, surfboards, fire extinguishers, thinner, solar water heaters, tires, tiles, kerosene, paints, agricultural chemicals, batteries, Buddhist altars, bowling balls, coin batteries, drugs, lithium batteries, etc.

Carry-in Disposal

Sun 8:30 AM - Noon
Fee: Burnable waste, etc. (excluding large garbage): 18 yen per kg
Large garbage: 23 yen per kg

PET bottles, plastic containers, used paper, and fabric will be collected for free if properly sorted.
